

Oakland women cagers surprise EMU, 67-61

Oakland University is turned for the title race in the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC).

The women's basketball team scored one of its biggest victories ever last Wednesday, beating Mid-American Conference (MAC) opponent Eastern Michigan University, 67-61.

Hurons were 7-0 entering the game. Oakland already has won two conference games, but the Pioneers are scheduled to play the league's toughest teams (Grand Valley and Saginaw Valley) later this month. The comeback victory over EMU gave the young Pioneers needed confidence and momentum for those future league games.

"For us every game is a big one," said Oakland University coach Rose Swidzinski. "You really can't underestimate any team because you never know how they're going to react. I believe any team is beatable on any given night."

"Overall, I thought we pulled together when we had to," she said. "It's a good sign for as young as we are that we were able to maintain our composure."

In a laxy first half, Oakland had trouble scoring, while the Hurons were able to penetrate and score a number of easy baskets. Even though they only attempted one foul shot, Oakland scored eight for the Pioneers, Eastern shot 45 percent from the field and built a 34-20 halftime lead.

Thanks to the fancy inside work of junior guards Donna Travis and Denise Woods, Eastern rolled up a 30-20 advantage with three minutes left in the first half. By intermission, Travis and Woods combined for 22 of their team's 34 points.

"We talked about how we weren't going for the ball in the first half," we weren't intense enough," said Swidzinski. "In the second half we picked up a little bit, and changed our zone defense. We were hoping to give them just one shot, trying to make them force their shots."

The strategy worked well as the Pioneers rallied in the second half, scoring the first 10 of 12 points enroute to tying the game. The Pioneers then

went on another 12-2 spurt and grabbed a 16-point lead of their own midway through the half, 51-41.

Sophomore forward Helen Shereda, the team's leading rebounder, scored 16 of her game-high 22 points in the second half. Eastern cut the lead to four points on three occasions late in the game, but the Pioneers hung on for the victory.

Shereda came on offensively for us and she was a big help," said Swidzinski. "Trudy (Dalecki) was offensively, but she helped out on the boards when we needed her."

Freshman K.D. Hart, a graduate of Farmington's Our Lady of Mercy High School, had one of her poorest nights of the year although she scored 14 points. The 5-6 guard made only six of

20 shots, but she did register seven assists.

Dalecki, who had been averaging 15 points, scored nine against the Hurons and grabbed a game-high 15 rebounds. Shereda contributed 10 rebounds and three assists.

Travis and Woods were the only players in double figures for the Hurons as they combined for 38 points (Travis with 22). The team's leading rebounder was Woods with 14.

"We're still trying to jell as a team," explained Swidzinski, whose overall record is 4-1. "We're still having problems with the freshmen trying to do too much. It's strictly freak mistakes."

The Pioneers will travel to Grand Valley on Jan. 16 and the University of

Teledo two days later, and will meet Saginaw Valley at home on Jan. 21.

Farmington High has a pair of talented divers this season in Rick Rossin and Greg Schuler.

Rossin, a senior, set pool and varsity records when he compiled 25.20 points last week to pace Farmington's 109-53 victory over Pontiac Northern in an Inter Lakes League meet at Northern. The win lifted Farmington to 3-1 overall and 1-0 in the ILL.

"Rossin and Schuler are both hard workers, and they'll both be around in the state finals," said Farmington coach Jack Merritt.

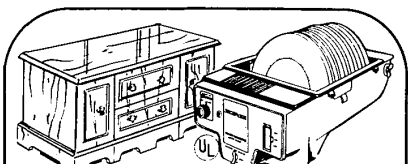
