

# Harrison, Farmington wrestlers win meets

Farmington High ran its varsity wrestling record to 10-4 overall with a 5-18 victory over Milford Lakeland in the Inter Lakes League last Thursday. Farmington is 4-0 in the ILL.

Farmington's Randy Stern won the 107-pound event with a 15-4 decision over Dave Peterson. Farmington's John Murphy needed 3:20 to pin Mike Sebring in the 114-pound battle.

In another meet last Thursday, Farmington Harrison defeated Northville, 45-15, in the Western Six League. Harrison is 8-9 overall and 3-1 in the WSL.

Randy Webb, Harrison's 100-pounder, decided Mark Tomczyk, 7-2. At 180 pounds, Harrison's Fred Blackmer pinned Louis Bustamanti in 1:10. Harrison's Rob Fawcett won at 130 pounds, pinning Matt Baker in 3:25.

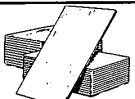
