Service stations can be fined up to S10,000 for pumping regular fuel into unleaded cars or tampering with auto emission systems.

Most violations occur at self-service gas stations and are prompted by the less expensive price of leaded fuel, which represents a savings of four to eight cents per gallon compared to the cost of unleaded gas.

In Canton Township, self-service stations are banned for safety considerations.

A Chrysler Corp. spokesman for engineering public relations said the use of regular fuel in an unleaded car will void the five-year warranty on the emission system, shorten the life of sparkplugs and cause the engine to pollute the air.

Said Evenson: "With leaded gaso-line, I don't think the customer is sav-ing that much. At Shell, the unleaded foel is higher in octane than the regu-lar. This means the prolonged use of regular gas in an unleaded car will result in poorer engine performance.

"In the end, the customer will be paying more in repairs."

ALL NEW CAR models, however, do not require unleaded fuel. Any vehicle exceeding 6.060 pounds in weight will run on any type gasoline. The same is true of cars with four-wheel drive. "People sort of shrug their shoulders when they see a new car needs

unleaded fuel," said L. John Miller, car salesman at Lou LaRiche Chevrolet in Plymouth Township.
"I think that's one reason for the sales spurt in the area of pick-ups and four-wheel drives—the customer can still use regular gas."


