CITY OF LATHRUP VILLAGE CITY UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION REPEALER ORDINANCE NO. 183

THE CITY OF LATHRUP VILLAGE ORDAINS:

I. TITLE AND PURPOSE

The Title of this Ordinance is "City Unemployment Compensation Repealer" and its purpose is to phase out the City Unemployment Compensation system which has been replaced by another system of benefits pursuant to mandatory State Legislation enacted in 1977 effective January 1, 1978.

II. REPEALER OF ORDINANCES

City Unemployment Compensation Ordinance No. 158 and the amendments thereto enacted as Ordinances No. 159, 165, and 169 are hereby repealed, provided however, those persons who would otherwise be entitled to benefits under the provisions of said Ordinances shall nonetheless be entitled to such benefits as they would otherwise have received had such Ordinances not been repealed to the extent, and only to the extent, mandated by the Legislation on this subject enacted by the Michigan Legislature as 1977 P.A. 277 to take effect on January 1, 1978.

III. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

This Ordinance is declared to be severable pursuant to the provisions of Section 7.8 of the Charter of this City and it shall be effective on February 3, 1978.
