Festival committee seeks logo

Warm weather may seem a long way off, but the Farmington Founders Festival Committee already is planning for the annual event.
The committee, under the leadership of General Chairman Terry Sever, has announced guidelines for a contest to select the logo and theme to represent this year's Festival.
This year's Festival will be from July 26-30.
The contest is open to any Farmington or Farmington Hills resident, or any student attending high school or university in Farmington or Farmington Hills. Themes are limited to ten words. But an entrant can submit more than one suggestion.

Prizes will include a \$25 U.S. Savings Bond, widespread use of the logo and theme as well as a place of honor in the Festival parade.
All entries become the property of the Farmington Founders Committee and must be postmarked by March 1, 1978. Entries should be mailed to Founders Festival Contest, care of Farmington Chamber of Commerce, 2310 Farmington Road, Farmington, 48221.
Entries also may be hand delivered to the chamber office no later than 4 p.m. on March 1.
The executive committee for the festival will judge the entries and its decision is final.

Members of the Festival Committee and their families are ineligible. The committee isn't liable for any damages arising out of the themes or logos submitted. It reserves the right to cancel the contest if inappropriate or insufficient entries are forthcoming.
