

Livonia Stevenson routs Plymouth Canton

Livonia Stevenson put together four solid rounds of basketball which featured potent offensive shooting enroute to an easy 87-64 non-league victory over Plymouth Canton Tuesday night at the Spartans gym.

Stevenson, 11-4 overall, came through with four 20-point plus quarters to end the Chiefs' modest four-game winning streak. Canton, leaders of the Western Six League, dropped to 9-4 overall.

The Spartans awesome shooting started with the opening jump ball as all five starters scored at least four points in a 26-point first quarter. Guard Jeff Hall hit four of five field goal attempts for eight points while teammates Dave Hall, Craig Beynard, Jack Lang and Art Wentz added four each.

Canton's free-shooting guard Butch King was the only bright spot in the Chiefs' 15-point first period as he scored eight points to keep the margin close.

Stevenson continued to score on the flat-footed Chiefs' defense, mounting a

41-21 advantage with 3:16 left in the half.

Canton managed to close the margin to 14 points, 65-52, at halftime but that was as close as it got.

Stevenson's star sophomore Dave Hall, who suffered a sprained ankle last Friday night, didn't seem to let the injury bother him as he opened the third period with the Spartans' first six points of the second half.

Hall was all over the court in that period, scoring 10 of his game-high 28 points. He also grabbed 12 rebounds.

Stevenson maintained its comfortable margin throughout the second half, leading 66-47 after three quarters before securing the 23-point victory.

Spartan coach George VanWagoner was extremely pleased with the performance of his squad calling it a "total team effort."

"When we execute, we are as good as anyone," VanWagoner said. "Canton's a good ball club. They beat Bentley (12-3) twice and I told my players they had to do a job. Canton was flat and we came out strong."

"It was a heck of a team effort. We shot well at the start and our defense

wasn't bad. Canton's got some good offensive players on its team."

The Chiefs' main offensive threat is King who scored 20 point but hit on only 19 of 21 shots from the floor. VanWagoner credited Lang with the strong defensive effort.

The only other Chiefs to score in double figures were Kurt Herbert with 12 points and captain Randy Rienas with 10.

Stevenson placed three others in double figures after Dave Hall as brother Jeff Hall, a senior, added 15, Wentz 13 and Lang 10. Beynard and Steve Priggen each added eight for the Spartans.

A somber Canton coach Casey Cavell wasn't happy with the letdown of his team.

"We were dead defensively and offensively," the Canton mentor said. "It's hard to spot a team which is as quick as Stevenson that many times as they had to do a job. Canton was flat and we came out strong."

"Stevenson was very sharp tonight and that was part of the problem," Cavell explained. "They reacted well

defensively and on the offensive boards."

CLARENCEVILLE-ST. AGATHA

Taking control of the contest with a strong rebounding effort, Clarenceville overran Redford St. Agatha Tuesday in a non-league basketball battle, 88-76.

Bill Peterson led the Trojans' rebounding game with 14, while Jim Byer pulled down eight. Peterson also charged Clarenceville's offensive attack with 24 points, while Jim McPhail added 15 and Byer scored 15.

"Basically the story of the game was our domination on the boards. We also beat them with our fast break," said Clarenceville coach Bob Wolf.

By the end of the opening quarter the Trojans were ahead 25-15, by the end of the half the score was 46-34, Clarenceville, and by the end of the third quarter the Trojans reigned 72-51.

"Our defense was not outstanding but they did the job. We dominated the boards so much that Agatha had a

hard time getting a strong offense rolling," Wolf said.

Bill McCafferty led the Aggies' offensive effort with 31 points, while Dave Monnett added 14 and Steve Peck tossed in 13.

"The score got close at the end only because we were playing the bench people," said Wolf.

As for the rebounding total, the Trojans collected 41, while the Aggies grabbed just 25.

The Clarenceville junior varsity also came out on top over Agatha, 60-48.

The Trojans upped their overall record for the season to 7-7 with the victory.

BISHOP BORGESS-GC EAST

Redford Bishop Borgess, which recently clinched a spot in the Catholic League cage playoffs, had to rally Tuesday night to slip past an upstart Garden City East.

Trailing 36-34 going into the final stanza, Borgess let its front line go to work. The trio of Dave DeCoster, Dan DeCoster and Mark Taylor combined to net 15 points in the fourth quarter to power Borgess past the Panthers.

East, playing cautious basketball through the second half, scored 15 points in the two final periods.

"They were playing ball up above the rim, said coach Billy Joe Young, who saw his Panthers drop their 14th game. "We just don't have anybody who can do that. Their inside men really played ball in the fourth quarter."

Borgess had taken a one-point, 13-12 first quarter lead, but a 16-point second quarter propelled East into a 28-22 halftime lead.

"They just did everything right," Young said. "They became much more aggressive on the offensive boards in the fourth quarter."

The win pushed Borgess' season record to 11-4. East, meanwhile, slumped to 1-14.

Lathrup matman seeks to avenge lone loss

Southfield-Lathrup's Rob Parent, one of the state's most talented high school wrestlers, will have a chance to avenge his only match loss this season as well as advance in the Class A state tournament next Saturday.

Parent, a junior, has a 4-1 individual record — the lone loss coming in the 121-pound finals at the Schoolcraft College Invitational on Jan. 7. He dropped a 6-5 decision to Thurston's Buddy Ault in that match.

If things go as expected, Ault and Parent will meet in the second match of the 122-pound (the weight limits were moved up a notch on Feb. 1) competition at the Walled Lake Western district.

Both wrestlers advanced to the regional with good showings in district competition last Saturday. Parent downed three opponents and won the 122-pound title at the Hazel Park High School district. Ault finished second in the same weight at the Walled Lake Western district.

Lathrup coach Ray Tooley is confident that Parent will whip Ault in the regional and then advance to the Class A state finals set for Feb. 17-18 at Western Michigan University.

"Rob has no doubts about it (the Ault match)," Tooley said. "He's looking forward to it. He's not afraid of it. Rob's dad took films of Ault's

(district) matches, so Rob has that guy down pretty good."

IN HIS THREE years of varsity wrestling at Lathrup, Parent has compiled an amazing 103-10 career record through last Saturday's district tournament.

He drew rave reviews from opposing coaches, including Bob Morrill, who has built Hazel Park into a prep wrestling powerhouse.

"He's a super kid," Morrill said. "He's just strong, a real tough kid. He's a 100-percent wrestler, but he looks like a natural athlete. I think he's in excellent in any sport."

In the district, Parent "wasn't really pushed," according to Tooley. He won the 122-pound final with an 8-1 decision over Hazel Park's Tom McIntosh.

Parent drew a bye in the opening round and then pinned Birmingham Seaholm's Kip Wilson in 2:44. He advanced to the finals with an 11-3 decision over Detroit Catholic Central's Mike DeMember in the semifinals.

Two other Lathrup wrestlers, seniors Dave Settsu and Edgar Casab, made it through the district and will compete in the Western regional.

Settsu, who has a 39-7 match record this season, finished second in the 158-pound competition. After drawing a first-round bye, he pinned Randy Springer of Troy Athens in 2:51, and then stopped Hazel Park's Ken Fraser, 5-1. In the 158-pound final, Catholic Central's Nadim Nadhir pinned Settsu in 2:50.

CASAB'S RECORD (7-3-1) isn't that impressive, but he didn't come out for wrestling until after the Christmas break. He finished fourth at 129 pounds, losing finally to Seaholm's Mike Clapperton, 5-1. Casab opened

with an 8-3 victory over Ferndale's Guy Roth, and then lost to Hazel Park's Joe Craig, 12-9.

Lathrup, which was missing six key wrestlers because of injuries and illness, scored 51 team points and finished seventh in the 14-school district field. Missing Lathrup wrestlers included Steve Krumer and George Schultz (shoulder injuries), Sonny Wehler and Nadim Kasab (flu), Ben Peach (dislocated elbow) and Jim Fish (foot injury).

Hazel Park won the district, scoring 209 points. Catholic Central was second with 169½, Ferndale and Madison Heights Lampshire each had 96½, Highland Park, 92, and Royal Oak Kimball, 52.

Southfield High, which has an inexperienced wrestling team, participated in the Walled Lake Western district, scoring no team points and finishing in a 14th-place tie with Livonia Bentley. No Southfield wrestlers advanced to the regional.
