Economists forecast **FACTORY** In 1978 Michigan is expected to record a third consecutive year of growth in personal income, along with a slight rise in employment, substantial state revenue increases, and a virtually unchanged rate of inflation, Univerty of Michigan economists predict. take hold about a year from now barring national policy actions to cut personal income taxes and increase the investment tax credit. The Michigan forecast is compiled by the U-M Research Seminar in Quantitative Economics, and suggests a rise in state personal income of 11.2 per cent, two percentage points above the Hymans-Shapiro forecast for U.S. personal income and only about one percentage point below the increase estimated for 1977.

The U.M conomists said total state employment will continue upward through mid-1979. Increase in non-manufacturing employment "probably represents a healthy redistribution of employment in the state," said the economists.




