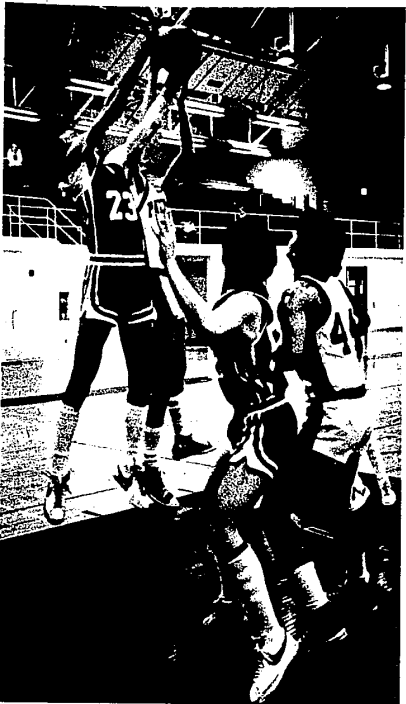


Lathrup whips Dondero; Christian falls
