Post Office Hikes Parcel Post Limit

The parcel post weight limit will be raised to 40 pounds for

will be raised to 40 pounds for shipments between first-class post offices after July 1. The maximum parcel post weight limit will be increased from 30 pounds on shipments between the larger post offices in the third through eighth par-cel post zones. (More than 150 miles.)

On packages sent locally and
to offices in parcel post zones
one and two, the celling has been
40 pounds. The maximum size
of packages sent between all
first-class offices remains 72
inches in combined length and
girth.

The size limit on parcels sent to or from smaller offices, sent to or from smaller offices, rural or star routes, military post offices, and all Alaskan and Hawaiian post offices stays at 70 pounds, with a combined length and girth of 100 inches. Postmaster Shivnen added.

Public Liuw 89-593, enacted Sept. 20, 1956, authorized the postal service in crease weight postal service in crease weight between larger cities, On July 1 of 1970 and 71, the length and girth limits are scheduled for rise to 78 and 84 fuches, respectively, on shipments between first-class post offices,


