Schoolcraft July Series
Mozart, Stravinsky Featured

What do Mozart and Stravinsky have in common? For one thing, they will be the featured composers during the four concerts offered as part of Schoolcraft College's summer music festival. The programs will be offered on the four Wednesdays this month beginning July 9.
But they have more in common than that, insists Wayne Dunlap, musical director and conductor of the Court Orchestra.
"THEY'RE BOTH classic composers. There's a clean precise quality about their music."
"There's also a high degree of musical craftsmanship."
"And they both showed versatility in all mediums - concert, opera, symphony. They showed the most advanced professional qualities of their ages."
Wayne A. Dunlap's career covered the last half of the 19th century. Igor Stravinsky, who was born in Russia and spent most of his adult life in Russia and the United States, had a composing career that spanned a half-century.
This is the third summer that Schoolcraft has offered a series of public programs on Wednesday evenings in conjunction with its summer music school.
HERE IS the lineup of dates and soloists:
● July 9—Members of the faculty will offer a chamber music concert indoors in the Liberal Arts Building theater. Faculty members include several members of the Detroit Symphony.
● July 16—In the first outdoor concert, Emily Mutter Austin will be heard as soloist in Mozart's fifth violin concerto.
● July 23—Pianist Martin Berkofsky, a young and vigorous New Yorker, will be soloist in the D minor Mozart concerto and in Stravinsky's "Capriccio for Piano and Orchestra."
● July 30—The Kenneth Jewell Chorale will sing Stravinsky's "Cantata" and Mozart's famed "Mass in C minor" (K. 427).
ALL PROGRAMS begin at 8:30 p.m. The three final programs will be outdoors between the wings of the Forum Building. Tickets at \$2 may be purchased at the door. There are no advanced sales and no reserved seats. In the event of bad weather, the final three programs will be moved indoors to the Waterman Campus Center.
Free parking is available in lots both south and north of the campus, located on Haggerty between Six and Seven Mile roads in Livonia.
DURING THE 1967 series, Dunlap featured the works of the classical Haydn and the modern Hindemith. Last year he featured the romantic Schubert and the neo-romantic Poulenc.
