



Screening out the shriveld grains from wheat seed before planting will remove one cause of spreading the new backerial disease of wheat which has been discovered in many states of the middle: West. This has been elearned by specialists of the Entited States Department of Agriculture who, in reoperation with the experiment stations of Kansas and Wisconsio, are studying the problem of controling this disease. Wheat kernels that dre plump do not contain bacterial envilles, but shriveded ones inten do.
