tient's bed. That did the work.

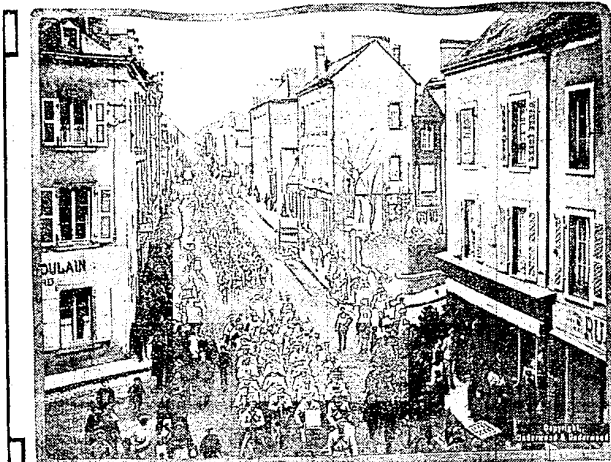
New Use for Corsets.

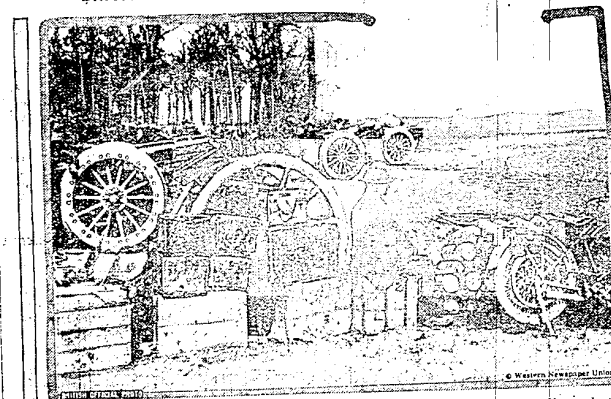
So that singers can use photographs
