Beineman, Schell Killings Related

ANN ARBOR — The murder of Eastern Michigan University coed Karen Sue Beineman appears more closely related to the killing of a Plymouth coed than to any of the five others that have occurred in this area in the last two years.

Among clues reported by police in the slaying of Miss Beineman is the description of a man she was last seen with before she disappeared Wednesday in Ypsilanti.

That description closely resembles that of a man who was last seen with Joan E. Schell, of Williams Street in Plymouth.

MISS SCHELL was reported getting into a red and black car which hid three men on June 30, 1968 in Ypsilanti.

One of the men was described as a white male, 20-years-old, about five feet eight inches tall, slender and muscular. His hair color was not given, but a composite drawing from the police shows his hair style as short on the sides with a sweep of bangs.

Miss Beineman was reported riding on the back of a motorcycle from a Ypsilanti wig shop last week with a man described as a white male, 22-years-old, six feet tall, with short dark-brown hair curled down over the forehead and with short sideburns. He had a thin to medium build.

descriptions are so general, however, that many suspects fitting the descriptions could be found in two minutes, and it would be difficult to question everyone who looks like either of the suspects.

For this reason, he said, the police are working on more expeditious leads at the present time.

THE BODY of Miss Schell, 20, an Eastern Michigan University coed, was found July 5, 1968 near the corner of Eckhart and Glacier Way outside of Ann Arbor.

Miss Beineman's body was found Saturday, a mile away, near the corner of Riverside Drive and Huron River Drive in Ann Arbor Township. She was 18 years old and a freshman at EMU.
