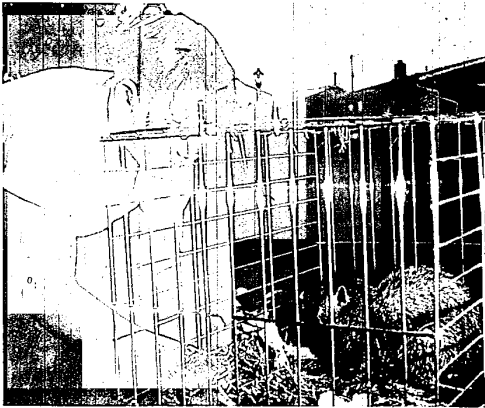

FARMINGTON  
Farmington will have a team in the 11th annual Hawaii International Billfish Tournament.

A four-man team of deep-sea fishermen will represent the area in competition with entrants from Australia, Japan, Kenya, the Philippines, Panama, Mexico, and other points.

The Farmington team will try its luck against 49 competitors August 15-24. The teams will fish out of Kailua Kona, on the island of Hawaii.

The team will represent Perkins Engines Inc., a firm which is building a new plant in a Farmington industrial subdivision.

"FARMINGTON will soon be our new home," explains Derek J. Wheeler, vice president of marketing for Perkins, a major supplier of diesel engines currently based in Wixom, another Detroit suburb. "So we decided to enter as a Farmington team, rather than a company team."

The Perkins fishing team will ride a 29-foot offshore fishing boat, appropriately dubbed "Miss Perkins."

Wheeler is serving as captain of the Farmington team. Other members include Derek Knowles, the company's western regional manager based in San Francisco; D.S. Lennox, president of Grace Brothers; and Frank Nibley, Hawaiian attorney and one of the organizers of the tournament.

"We will do our best to come back with a trophy for our new neighbors," Wheeler promised.
