

# New fishing map for 7 counties

What are the two Oakland County lakes stocked with salmon? What are the two Oakland lakes with better-than-average perch fishing?

You might find out by asking an expert, or you might get better information on every public fishing water in seven counties by consulting the new "Southeastern Michigan Fishing Map."

To get a free copy, visit any Ford dealer in Oakland, Wayne, Macomb, Washtenaw, St. Clair and Monroe counties. It's the joint product of the Michigan Department of Natural Resources and the Metro Detroit Ford Dealers Association.

"THE DNR, DAD & I put together but didn't have the money to publish it," said Ed Schrad, chairman of the association. The company's public relations office did the art work and took care of printing it.

Until now, we really didn't know what was available for fishermen in the area," said Schrad.

We feel the map accomplishes two things: it will aid you in your search for a lake or stream where fish are known to be plentiful, and it will help you catch them when you get there.

Maybe 50,000 fans turn out to watch the Ford in the Stadium, but there are more than a million licensed fishermen in the metropolitan area.

With the state's effort to improve water quality and add new stocks of fish to the waters, and with gasoline prices due to the recent rise, local anglers will find the map mighty handy.

IT LISTS 140 lakes in streams and shows them on a fairly clear road map.

The charts tell whether the body of water has a boat ramp, pier, fishing or shore fishing. Only waters with public access and streams of general interest are included.

It lists species of fish that are available in "better than average" quantities. The list begins with the ever-present sunfish and goes through all the warm-water sport fish, concluding with five different species of the trout family.

Any special information—such as no motors allowed or a particular stock of fish—is mentioned. That's where you find out that Coss Lake has a stock of kokanee salmon, Orchard Lake a stock of king salmon, and Orton and White lakes are the only two in the county considered good for perch.

STAN LEVYENSE, a former DNR fishery biologist who's now with the state travel bureau, has written a description of each species along with tips on how to catch them.

Local information came from Ron Spiller, fishery biologist at the DNR's Pontiac district office. He enters parks, personnel and biologists throughout the region.

This isn't propaganda. The state's leadership, both in the executive office and in the legislature, really have been taking a greater interest in southeastern Michigan in recent years.

The dealers association kept commercial promotion to a rock bottom minimum. They have performed a genuine public service with this map and guide.

# Viking reports are available at UM shop

Special reports on the activities of the Viking space missions exploring Mars are available at the University of Michigan Exhibit Museum Gift Shop. They are not available by mail.

The reports are prepared by Jim London, staff astronomer and chief astronomer for the UM Exhibit Museum's Planetarium.

London is currently at Jet Propulsion Laboratory in Pasadena, Calif., where a National Aeronautics and Space Administration flight team is tracking and commanding the two Viking spacecraft.

Launched Aug. 20, 1975, Viking I is now orbiting the red planet. Viking II, launched Sept. 9 last year, is scheduled to follow in orbit on Aug. 7.

"ALTHOUGH THE reports will contain great detail, they are non-technical, highly readable and will offer a good deal more information than will standard news accounts," says London.

In his first report, London points out that the most published aspect of Viking is its search to find out whether there is life on Mars.

"However, the life search, important though it is, is merely one of 13 major in-

vestigations about the Martian surface, interior, atmosphere, and space environment," he writes. "The entire package could be removed and Viking would still rank as one of the most important space missions ever flown."

Viking I made at least one major discovery even before it arrived in orbit. he continues.

From observations made during its approach, Viking showed that the tiny amount of water vapor in the Martian atmosphere is not uniformly mixed, but is strongly concentrated toward the surface, so that at least some places on this supposedly desert planet may be what even an Earthling would call "humid," London says.

"Since all known Earthly life forms require water, and water is scarce on Mars, the finding that it is concentrated at exactly the spot where a hypothetical Martian organism would need it, near the surface, enhances the probability of life as we know it."

# Benefits gained in HMO service

Over the past several years, health maintenance organizations (HMOs) have emerged as an alternative to the traditional fee-for-service payment plan for health care.

The federal HMO Act of 1973 defines an HMO as a system of health care which provides health care services to a voluntarily enrolled group on a prepaid basis.

The most important feature of the one-stop HMO plan is the emphasis shifts from curing disease to preventing it. Since all medical services are paid for in advance, the consumer probably will consult the doctor more frequently, and lessen the need for hospitalization.

According to Blue Cross estimates, hospital costs are expected to reach \$1,000 per day by 1980. Conventional health insur-

ance, by reimbursing heavily for hospital care, encourages patients to enter the hospital for illness that might have been prevented or for services that could be performed in the doctor's office.

Comparisons between HMOs and fee-for-service subscribers show that HMO participants have cut their hospital stays by 50 per cent.

Advocates claim other attractions in the HMO system. One is that the teamwork and "peer review" of the plan may contribute to higher standards of excellence among physicians.

The HMO structure also can free the doctor from administrative tasks and leave him free to practice medicine exclusively. Some HMOs run health education programs for subscribers.
