The hand in the diagram was reported to us by Marshall Miles of California. He is one of the leading players in the country.
Sitting South he was declarer in three notrump and lost all thirteen tricks.
West led the jack of spades, the king was played and dummy and East cashed six spade tricks. West discarded two diamonds and two clubs.

East won a heart and the king was trapped; the defense collected seven heart tricks in addition to their six spade tricks for a 900 point set.

Joan and Vince Remy of Southfield held the East-West cards at another table. North passed, Vince preempted two spades, South overcalled in diamonds: Joan bid four hearts to end the bidding.

She made game, losing two clubs and a diamond for a very good match point score.

But not a top, for it didn't compare to the top points at the Marshall Miles table.

To Quote Mr. Miles, "I believe I have established a world record which may be tied, but can never be beaten."

Birmingham Bloomfield Art Association (BBAA) will offer 112 classes and workshops in fine arts, crafts, art history, art appreciation and art education during its fall term.

The 1976-77 year will offer more courses on a broader scheduling basis.
