Southfield Mrs. Morris (Goldie) Adler will be the honoree at the Oct. 28 Women's Division Israel Bond Fashion Show highlighting collections of several Israeli internationally famous fashion houses and a selection of haute couture and furs especially created by Israel's top designers. A Michigan premiere, the fashion festival is scheduled to tour 40 major cities in the United States and Canada. Held Thursday, October 28 at Congregation Shaarey Zedek in Southfield, admission will be through purchase of a State of Israel Bond.

Born and educated in New York, Mrs. Adler has been a Detroitite for the past 28 years. She is the mother of Mrs. Eh (Shulamith) Benstein and the grandmother of Judy, Jeremy, Joel and Miriam.
