

Indian Exhibition Paints Life Scene

Walking through the exhibit "Indians!!!" currently at the Detroit Historical Museum, Woodward and Kirby, is much like embarking on an exciting journey through the life and culture of Indian tribes that inhabited the Great Lakes area during prehistoric and historic times.

"Indians!!!" features such prehistoric material as skeletal remains, pottery vessels and arrowheads from the Fort Wayne Indian Mound. Of particular interest is clothing, tools, weapons, toys, pipes and ceremonial objects used by the Great Lakes Indians. This Woodland Indian Collection was a gift to the museum from the Detroit Historical Society Guild.

Pre-Broadway Run Opens At Playhouse

The Cherry County Playhouse in Traverse City will host the pre-Broadway run Aug. 12 through 17 of the new play "Butterflies Are Free."

Highlighting the exhibit is a life-sized habitat grouping of Chippewa Indians with a wigwam, birchbark canoe and mannequins dressed in authentic costume. The exhibit also boasts 22 original oil paintings by Phyllis H. Keller of Lead, S.D., which depict dance interpretations of North American Indians. A collection of native Michigan food plant reproductions illustrate the foods used by the Great Lakes Indians. The Detroit Historical Museum is open Tuesday through Sunday 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.
