**College library open for Farmingtonians**

Residents of the community are invited to use the Orchard Ridge Campus library from 8 a.m. - 9 p.m. Monday through Thursday, and 8 a.m. - 5 p.m. on Friday. The Orchard Ridge Campus, located on Orchard Lake, south of Twelve Mile, has more than 55,000 volumes, 1,000 periodicals, as well as national newspapers on microfilm. These include the New York Times since 1950 and the Wall Street Journal and Christian Science Monitor since 1960. The library maintains a collection of current fiction and non-fiction of general interest and reference aids, including telephone books for all major cities in the world.

**Finnish taught**

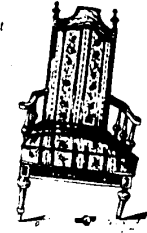
