KNITTING AND KNOTTING will be offered on Tuesdays from 10 a.m. to 11 a.m. There is a \$10 charge plus materials. Bring scissors, yarn and needles. Materials can be purchased from the instructor for each project.

DRIED FLOWER ARRANGEMENTS will be offered on Thursdays from 10 a.m. to noon. The course costs \$15 plus materials. Students are encouraged to bring old-fashioned flowers which can be used in the arrangement of natural materials. Teachers will have materials to sell for the first class.

DRIED FLOWER CRAFT WORKSHOP will be conducted on Wednesdays from 1-3 p.m. There is a \$15 fee plus material costs. This is a structured class. Specific projects will be made. Projects will include a basket on a board arrangement in a box, fruit arrangement and an all round dried flower arrangement. Bring scissors, wire clippers and a ruler. Materials can be purchased from the instructor for each project.

HOME DECORATING will be discussed on Wednesdays from 1-3 p.m. There is a \$15 charge plus materials. Learn the basics of home decorating, color schemes and styles.

KNITTING will be available for beginners on Thursdays between 12 p.m. There is a \$10 charge. Bring size eight knitting needles and one skein of large knitting yarn. More advanced knitters should bring a project.

MACRAME will be discussed on Thursdays from 10 a.m. to noon. There is a \$15 charge plus materials. Learn to make wall hangings, plant hangers and jewelry using basic knots. Beginners bring through a pair of cotton fabric rubber bands, scissors, T pins and macrame pad.

MATRICES FOR MOLE and others will be discussed on the 10 a.m. to 11 a.m. and 11 a.m. to 12 p.m. There is a \$15 charge plus materials. Learn to make point stitches by making a sampler. Instructor will have kits for about \$10. This is a five-week class.

PUNTING, BEGINNING AND INTERMEDIATE will be offered on Tuesdays between 12-3 p.m. There is a \$10 charge plus materials. Learn to make point stitches by making a sampler. Instructor will have kits for about \$10. This is a five-week class.

HOUSE PLANTS will be discussed on Mondays between 1-3 p.m. There is a \$15 charge plus materials. Cuttings and transplanting are included in the course. This is a workshop.
