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Group seeks labels for new equipment

The Michigan Jaycee Auxiliary will hold a year-long fund raising drive to purchase an echo cardiograph for the Children's Hospital at the University of Michigan.

The Jaycees have made arrangements with Gerber Products Company whereby the company will redeem labels from any Gerber baby food, cereal, or juice collected by the Jaycees, up to a maximum of \$10,000. Gerber has agreed to allow one-fifth of a cent per label, plus a bonus of \$30 for each \$1,000 worth of labels collected by the Michigan Jaycee Auxiliary.

Mrs. William (Lois) Yates of Fremont has been elected state chairwoman of the project. Local chairwoman is Sue Templeton of Livonia.

Ms. Templeton has announced that labels will be collected and verified at the district level.

Gerber salesmen will visit district collec-

tion sites prior to state meetings and verify the counts, thus enabling the Jaycees to make quarterly reports.

Verified labels will then be marked, to indicate they have been counted.

Collection points in the Livonia area will be announced as soon as plans have been finalized.

The echo cardiograph is a machine which monitors the heart and chest cavity. It is a non-traumatic approach, which enables physicians to "view" the chest cavity functions in infants and children without performing surgery or catheterization.

It is not necessary to be a member of the Michigan Jaycee Auxiliary in order to participate in this worthy project.

Anyone with Gerber labels may donate them and they will be counted toward the purchase of the cardiograph machine for Children's Hospital.
