3d quarter reminder: Social Security due

Monday is the last day for Michigan employers to report and pay Social Security and withheld federal income taxes for the third quarter of 1976.

Employers have until Nov. 10 to file Form 941, “Employer’s Quarterly Federal Tax Return,” if they have deposited the entire quarterly tax liability on time in a federal reserve bank or authorized commercial bank.

Employers should use the preaddressed Form 941 mailed to them by the IRS or obtain copies of the form from the nearest IRS office.

IRS Publication 15, “Circular E—Employer’s Tax Guide,” is free from IRS offices to provide more information for employers.

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6th law school is not needed

A 22 per cent increase in the number of lawyers in the past five years has led the state board of education to recommend a five-year delay in establishing another state-supported law school.

The board said the number of lawyers produced by the state’s present schools is enough to meet demands for at least the next five years.

State-supported schools Michigan State Western Michigan and Grand Valley have discussed establishing a law school. There are five other law schools in the state.

A report to Gov. William Milliken said the law schools are providing 1,200 new lawyers a year. The number of licensed lawyers has increased to almost 11,000 in 1976 compared to 11,000 in 1971. The number of lawyers has increased in all but 11 of Michigan’s 43 counties.

Although there is an adequate supply of lawyers, there is a need for additional law-related courses in both high school and college, the report said.
