

# Borg, Nastase compete in Olsonite

Four of the world's highest ranked tennis stars including Wimbledon champion Bjorn Borg and Ili Nastase, who was runner-up to Borg at Wimbledon, will be competing this week in the \$10,000 Olsonite Tennis Classic to be held at Olympia Stadium this Friday and Saturday.

Viewing of the two-day event will be fortunate world champions. Rod Mayer and Vito Gerulaitis, the young American star, Gerulaitis eliminated defending champion Kennerly at Wimbledon by hitting long drives that set match tiebreak numbers in the quarter finals.

Through the tournament, Borg will have won the Olsonite Tennis Classic in ten of his 11 previous years. The players will be competing for \$20,000 for the singles championship.

**FOR BORG AND NASTASE**, the money may not be the only reward. The two have met in four major tournaments with each player winning twice. The Olsonite Tennis Classic may provide the personal tie breaker.

Nastase, debuffed by duel with Borg by beating the 20-year-old Swede three sets to one at the winner take all Oly Open in Norway. Borg flew in to the challenge match with Nastase one day after winning \$80,000 at the World Invitational Tennis Classic in South Carolina, crushing Ahe 6-1, 6-2.

The Swedish New Yorker has claimed two victories over Nastase and one over Rod Hoadwin in U.S. WCT competition.
