

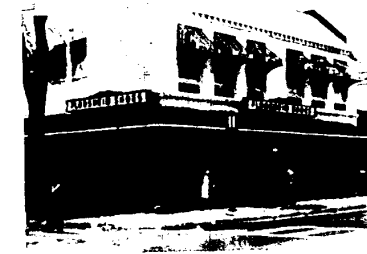
## The Table Setting

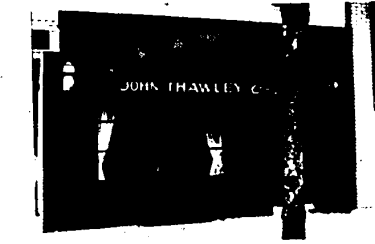
## Stewart Fabrics

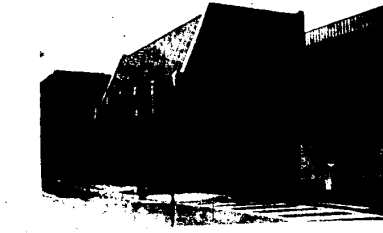
## Sherman Shoes
