Brotherton studies health insurance

After spending nine months on a Republican task force studying health insurance, State Rep. Walter Brotherton (R-Farmington) says that national health insurance is unnecessary.

"Probably the most significant discovery is that Michigan doesn't need national health insurance because the resources exist for most residents to be adequately covered," said Brotherton.

Brotherton lauded the results of the 62 page report which recently was released.

Assertive class is scheduled

A series of six seminars offering instruction in assertive behavior for men and women will begin in Farmington Hills on Oct. 23 at 7 p.m. Nov. 4 in the civic center building, 2202 Orchard Lake Road in the lower level conference room.

Dr. Lois Brooks and Dr. Paul Frey will be the co-leaders. These seminars are being sponsored by the educational services of Anderson Counseling Associates.

During assertiveness training, the co-leaders will define the difference between assertion and aggression and non-aggression and politeness. The program is designed to assist in the identification and acceptance of personal rights and rights of others.

Participants will, with direction and group support, experiment with new behavior. Emphasis will be on the development of skills and on applying them responsibly.

Brooks is a visiting lecturer at Eastern Michigan University and is supervisor of counseling practitioners.

Frey, a clinical psychologist, is involved in crisis intervention and in training of paraprofessionals and professionals for crisis intervention phone service.
