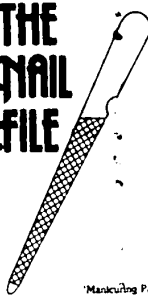

Lung association sells Yule cards

The 1976 Christmas cards from the Christmas Seal People, the American Lung Association of Southeastern Michigan, are now available in the metropolitan Detroit area.

This holiday season, the lung association is offering 11 greeting cards and an attractive postcard, which is a reproduction of one detail in the 1976 Christmas Seals and handy for holiday notes.

The Christmas card selection includes eight exclusive patterns, classic Christmas Seal designs from the years 1930 to 1942. Another design shows the Christmas scene created by a sheet of 1976 Christmas Seals, an elegant batik pattern "partridge in a pear tree" and an old fashioned sleigh ride scene. Other greeting card designs were created by school children as Christmas seal art.

The Christmas cards, which are priced from \$4.95 to \$7.75 and are available in packs of 25, are designed as an additional source of income for the association's work against lung diseases, and programs against smoking and air pollution.

Each attractive card is tax-deductible and includes this message: "This greeting helps support the nationwide health programs of the American Lung Association and its affiliates in the fight against lung disease. Personalized imprinting is available for an additional \$1 for the first time and \$1.50 for each additional line.

The postcard is priced at \$2.50 for a pack of 25.

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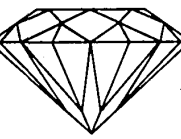
