Five-day ski weeks there for about \$150 include accomodations, meals, lifts and ski lessons—lift tickets are valid on all lifts in the complex

There's plenty of good sking closer to home if time is a factor and you are a 'boost Michigan' fan in such case, check out the local and Boyne-area packages

Since cross-country skiing is catching on like all outdoors, many local organizations are offering lesson packages for this sport. You can call your local Y or recreation department to find if they have cross country.

The Cranbrook Educational Community, that great complex on Lone Pine Road in Bloomfield Hills, has excellent response to its tidy cross-country package. The orientation session (indoors) and two lessons in the snow costs \$12 for a single and \$20 for two. Skis are available to rent through the instructor, giving you a chance to decide if this rigorous sport is really for you.

No age limit for cross-country skiers, it's as popular with seniors as it is with the youngsters

Indoor sports will welcome tickets to their favorite team events—Red Wings, Pistons. Those whose favorite outdoor activity is walking slowly through sand bordered by surf, would welcome a delightful remembrance like a couple of tickets for a long weekend in Jamaica, Bermuda, or any of the lovely Caribbean islands.

If you perfer, by dint of either time or wallet, to fly armchair, the Community House of Birmingham travel series continues after the first of the year with six films. They are: Jan. 21-22, "Angola—A Different Africa;" Feb. 4-5, "Germany;" Feb. 18-19, "Winter in Mexico;" March 4-5, "A New Norway;" March 18-19, "In Search of Singapore;" and April 8-9, "Lumberjack in Alaska."

There is also an excellent travel series at the Detroit Institute of Arts.

And if your gift recipients are of a scientific turn of mind—even if they just enjoy—a membership to the Cranbrook Institute of Science is something to consider. Student memberships to this are \$10 a year, individual adult memberships are \$15 and family, \$25.
