Farmington pair shine in loss

Farmington behind hot-shooting guards Rich Mihver and Dick Radatz held a first quarter advantage, but the height and strength of Livonia's Bentley proved too much to handle over the long haul.

The Bulldogs' Tuesday evening trip

Bentley started with a 1-31 zone defense but the Falcons denied the wall with a nifty shooting performance, out-pacing their host during the first eight minutes.

One of those things was the shooting coach of Farmington's 6'6" center and a transfer student from West Germany.

Harrison's performance overshadowed the excellent shooting nights of Radatz and Mihver, who counted 19 and 15 points respectively.

Bob Finkel scored 17 points for the Falcons and Randy Meier added 11.

Craig Furlong, with 16 points and Steve Thomsen, who totaled 11, also entered their names in the double-digit column of the score book for Bentley.

Furlong kept his posse played both ends of the floor and rebounded well. Jackson complimented, "The Bentley coach also singled out the improved play of Dan Moore."
