Some 2,000 osteopathic physicians, their spouses and guests, attended the five-day postgraduate session sponsored by the AOA and 10 specialty practice affiliates.

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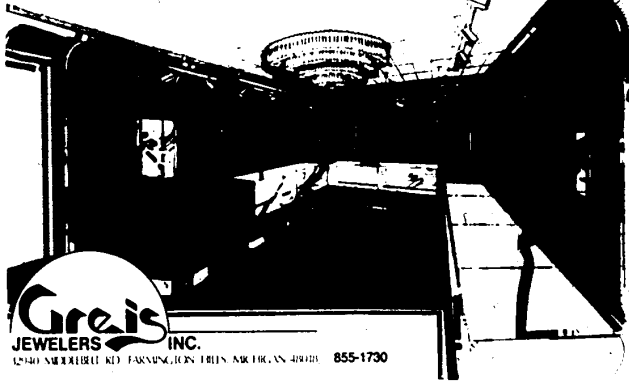
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
