

Crafts at Christmas' featured at Ford Museum

Henry Ford Museum recreates the special spirit that marked Christmas long ago this holiday season. Continuing through Jan. 2, The Crafts

at Christmas' recalls the quieter days when Americans had time to enjoy the simple pleasures of Yuletide festivities and fellowship.

Along the museum's street of Early American Shops, more than a dozen costumed craftsmen demonstrate the skills that provided earlier generations with not

only holiday luxuries, but the necessities of life as well. Bayberry candles, baskets and brooms, wooden toys and fresh green wreaths are among the items taking form under the skilled hands and watchful eyes of these experienced artisans.

The domestic arts are an important part of these demonstrations, too. Still more craftsmen weave cloth, stitch colorful quilts and bake tasty Christmas cookies according to the traditions of long ago. Visitors also may watch demonstrations of lace-making, macramé, counted thread embroidery, tie-dyeing and doll-making.

Prizes for the winner will include a beautiful camping ensemble and a \$300 Parisian Sewing School Scholarship.

Hours in the museum are 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday and 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on weekends. From Dec. 26, the museum will remain open until 8:30 p.m. with a special program each evening in the museum theater and food service available at family prices in the museum's Heritage Hall dining room.

Museum admission is \$3 for adults and \$1.25 for children six through 12. Children under six are admitted free.
