Tax aide program to be repeated

Members of the Farmington Hills chapter of the American Association of Retired Persons (AARP) are signing up now for January classes so they may help other seniors and retirees with their 1976 income taxes.

The chapter, performed the same service last year, without charge, through the federal Tax Aide program.

This year, 12 members will offer assistance with the preparation of 1976 federal, state and Hometown Tax Credit forms on 11 dates, on four locations.

Ivar Nylin, who headed the Tax Aide committee last year, and will do it again this year, asks residents who in the service be prepared when they come for assistance.

They must bring their 1976 W and 1999 forms, the amount of interest, dividends and social security received in 1976 and the amount of real estate taxes or rent paid in 1976. Nylin said.

A copy of their 1975 tax return is helpful to tax and all assistance is offered under confidential circumstances. If people they will start getting those things together now.

MEMBERS FROM the local AARP chapter will take their classes in Farmington Cultural Center where agents from the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) will review tax regulations and forms pertaining to 1976 income tax reporting.

They will then be available to help others between 12:30 and 3:30 pm on the following dates and locations:

At Senior Center in American Legion Hall, 3075 Grand River, Farmington on Jan. 23 and 27, and on Feb. 6 and 22. In Nardin Park United Methodist Church, 2627 Eleven Mile, in Farmington Hills on Feb. 2 and 16. In Farmington Community Library on Liberty Street on Feb. 17 and March 6.

In Redford Township Library, 1879 Northline on Feb. 1 and 13 and on March 19.
