I have a three-year-old female Samoyed who has had over three to four weeks. She urinates all night when she is in heat. What can be done?

Dear ST:

What you report concerning frequency of your pet's heat cycle is not uncommon in cats. They will return to heat every few weeks until they are mated. Sometimes a cyst on an ovary will be responsible for this. Crying is a normal part of the sexual stimulation at that time. I would heartily advise that you have her spayed soon, for your sake as well as the sake of your pet.

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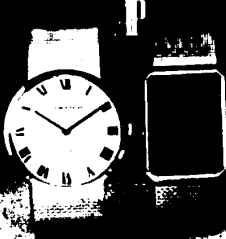

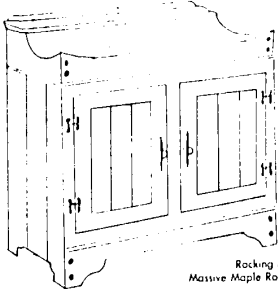
