Old Winery restaurant is one step closer to opening

Farmington area residents soon will be able to enjoy another restaurant in lown if a group of businessmen are successful in their remodeling efforts of the old winery on Grand Rivér at the base of Orchard Lake Road. This is the third time the license thas changed hands among investors who wanted to remodel the building.

We should be ready to open be-tween 60 and 90 days after the state li-

quor commission gives its approval." said Teichner. "We expect to wait

three to four months before the com-mission gives its approval.

The investors plan to integrate the buildings history into the restaurant's decor.

"We will remove the vats in one room to give its a restricted dining space." Teichner said We plan to open the bricked-in windows that were used when the building was a power house."

THE TIN WALLS and roof of the loading dock will be replaced by brick.

A brick fireplace and bar will be added to the interior. The restaurant will seat 304 diners.

Another change in the old wine plant is the addition of ramps inside, which will lead to the bar and serve handicanoped patrons.

The glass linings of the wine vats will be preserved, as much as possible, according to Teichner.

"We want to keep the design

simple. We will add some antiques to the interior," he said. The partners intend to operate a family restaurant, specializing in spa-ghetti. "The highest priced meal will cost \$455." Teichner said. "We'll serve husiness lumbes also"

\$495." Teichner said. "We'll serve business lunches, also."
One of the problems that face the four men is deciding on a heating method for the building. "The primary concern of the health department is the ventilation," Teichner conceded. "We don't know how we'll heat the building yet. We'll either go with gas heating or steam."
The men are leasing the space from John White, the building's owner. In addition to planning for restaurant space. White will use the building for offices and storage.

SIX BUSINESSES ARE LEASING space in the building, which stood vacant since the Cadillac Wine Co. left it in 1969.


