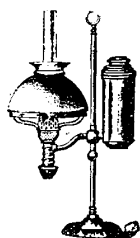

Police seek payment for broken windows

Three Walled Lake youths are faced
with the possibility of paying 30 Farmington
residents a total of \$3,000 to re-
place the car windows which were
shot out last week.

Daniel Wilson Sparks, 17, and Mi-
chael Dale Buckner, 18, of Walled
Lake told police they were responsible
for a trail of shattered windows in
Southfield, Farmington and Farmington
Hills.

A 15-year-old boy was charged with
malicious destruction of property,
also. His case will be heard in pro-
bate court.

Farmington Police are hoping they
can obtain restitution for the 30 car
owners.

"We're asking persons who have
had their windows shattered to con-
tact their insurance company," said
Lt. John Santamuro.

"We're encouraging the insurance
companies to go for restitution," he
said.

THERE ARE DIFFICULTIES in
the attempt at gaining restitution; he
conceded.

"It may be too much money for the
vandals to repay. I doubt if they can
come up with it," he said.

The vandals may be unable to re-
call damaging a specific car.

The shattered windows were reported
to police during the evening of Jan.
11. Cars parked at the K-Mart shop-
ping center, Halstead and the Bel-
Aire Lanes, Orchard Lake Road, were
damaged.

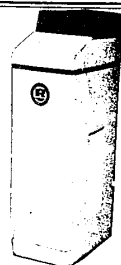
Windows were shattered in cars
