# Extend Deadline For Tree Sale

The deadline has been extended for the Farmington residents to purchase trees for fall delivery.

Mrs. Dorothy Gordon, chairman of the Township Beautification Committee, announces residents will have until Sept. 10 to submit their orders.

The township board ordered 500 trees and some are still left, explains Betty Frankel, committee member, but they are selling at the rate of eight to 10 a day.

The trees were ordered when the Beautification Committee decided to start a tree planting program in the township. They will be delivered in early November and all are guaranteed for one full year.

Varieties available include sugar maple, Norway maple, and skyline treeless honey locust. They will be branched small trees with trunk diameters ranging from 1-1/4 to 1-1/2 inches.

The sugar maple will grow to 100 feet tall at maturity, the Norway maple to about 40 feet tall, and the honey locust between 40-75 feet. Cost for the trees is under \$25. If planted by the township on public right-of-way, the charge will be \$25 per tree. The charge will be \$25 if planted by township on private property. If the owner does his own planting, cost of the tree will be \$18.

# Completes Of Air Training

Naval Aviation Officer Candidate Dave Sartin, son of Mr. and Mrs. Kenneth A. Hatcher of 33709 Oakland, Farmington, has completed a phase of training at the Naval Aviation Schools Command aboard the Naval Air Station, Pensacola, Fla.

He will now proceed to the next phase of his training in the program.

The course included instruction in naval history, world affairs, naval justice, naval leadership, propaganda, physical fitness and navy orientation.

While on duty with 175th RR Co. at Bion H. Harshfield was awarded the Bronze Star for exemplary service. He also won the Vietnam Service medal.

Harshfield is a 1965 graduate of Farmington High School and attended Eastern Michigan University. He was employed by the Federal Bureau of Investigation before his enlistment.

During the course, he was trained in leadership, tactics of small units and use of infantry weapons. He also received instruction in map and aerial photography reading, guerrilla warfare and counter-insurgency operations.
