THE COUNTYWIDE alert system is expected to be in operation by next tornado season, a year after the money package was approved by the county board and two years after the March 20, 1976 devastation. The sirens will be activated by radio from the National Weather Service at Metropolitan Airport. The system will include 88 new sirens, 70 re-furbished sirens and a communications system would be expanded in future years until there are 190 strens evocyring 95 per cent of the county in 1880.

Local agencies will be able to sound

sirens independently in their own com-munities.

New siren equipment will cost \$233,000 and installation \$71,000 for a total of \$304,000.

Of this, the federal government will put up half, or \$152,000; the county 24 per cent, or \$73,000; and local units 26 per cent, or \$79,000.


