## \$5 charge suspended on phone listing for spouses

Husbands and wives can have both their first names listed together in the telephone directory without extra charge, and the Michigan Bell Telephone Company won't be allowed to make a service charge for changing the listing until after May 31, the Michigan Public Service Commission has ruled.

Last year Bell proposed to list a couple's combined names twice in directories, making a 45-cent monthly charge for the second listing. In December, the commission ordered an investigation of Bell's plan and called for public hearings on similar proposals.

Bell applied Jan. 14 to withdraw its proposal, and on Feb. 1 began offering a directory listing of two first names and a single last name at no address, without extra monthly charge. A couple's listing can be, for example, either Jones, James-Mary or Jones, Mary-James, whichever the customers select. The combined first-

## Druggists no longer need OK to switch to generic pills

Michigan pharmacists can now dispense generic drugs without receiving a formal request from the customer, but amending the state's generic drug substitution law to this effect was signed Jan. 12 by Gov. William Milliken.

The change also requires the pharmacist to dispense a lower cost drug if requested. Previously, the law gave the pharmacist the option of substituting, upon request. The amendments were needed because an attorney general's opinion had held that the existing law required that the consumer make a request prior to receiving a generic substitute.

## Signal is installed after 2 year dispute

The Oakland County Road Commission has installed a traffic signal at the end of a shopping center driveway where two Farmington Hills residents died in auto accidents within the last two years.

The intersection of the south driveway in the Orchard-Lake Shopping Center, located on Orchard Lake Road between Thirteen and Fourteen Mile in Farmington Hills, was recognized as a safety hazard by the county road commission, according to county commissioner Robert McConnell.

However, the \$8,000 signal was financed by the developers of the shopping center after the county reneged on its offer to pay half of the installation costs.

The county said that the center would benefit the most from the signal. It disagreed with that because at the same time the intersection is a safety hazard," McConnell said.

The county plans to widen the road within the next two years, according

## Divorce decision takes years

A Michigan State University study of more than 400 individuals involved in divorce proceedings in Wayne County Circuit Court showed that 75 per cent of the actions were begun by women and then only after considering such action for three or four years.

Making the decision to separate, said Dr. Prudence Brown, assistant professor of social work at MSU, created the greatest crisis, generally coupled with or followed by strong personal feelings of guilt and failure.

Dr. Brown found, through follow-up interviews with about half of those divorced, that the women were generally astonished and pleased that they had survived the divorce and had begun to grow in self-assurance and self-esteem.
