Convention Alternate Sees National Primary Valve

Farmington's Isabel Haynes came home from Miami convinced that a national primary would be better than a national convention for selecting presidential candidates.

"My reaction is that the whole system is wrong," said the president of the Republican Women's Federation of Michigan, who was an alternate-at-large in the state's convention delegation.

"Several of us talked a lot about it in Miami," she added, "I have the feeling that before too long both the Republican and Democratic parties will move to a national presidential primary."

THE CONVENTION excitement behind her, Isabel Haynes was ready to plunge into the political work that has filled a large share of her life for a long time.

NATIONAL CONVENTIONS, Mrs. Haynes added, just don't reflect our concept of one-man one-vote.

It was several years later that Arthur Elliott, then Oakland County Republican chairman, began encouraging the organization of women's GOP groups.

"Ruth Robertson, the Michigan woman on the platform committee, pointed out that in committee she had exactly the same say as the woman delegate from Mississippi," Mrs. Haynes said.

Isabel Haynes helped organize and served as first president of the Women's Republican Organization of Farmington, one of the first members of the Oakland County Council of Republican Women's Clubs.

"And think how many more Republicans Ruth represented!"

In the years she has been actively engaged in politics, Mrs. Haynes has noted a big upswing in grass roots interest, and she credits it to the great increase in women's organizations.

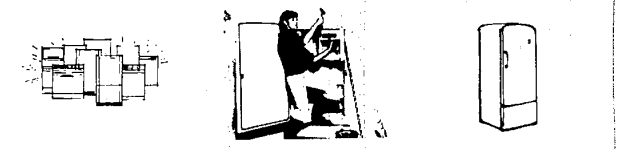
