Classes Popular

A summer session enrollment of 1,182 students—an increase of 130 over last year and the highest ever for the session in the history of the college—has been reported by Schoolcraft College Registrar Norman E. Dunn.

The enrollment was significant in another way than simply setting a high for the summer session, Dunn said. Technical-vocational course enrollment for the period reached 50 per cent of the total student body, highest ever for the career curriculum at Schoolcraft.

Dunn said there has been a steady increase over the years in the career programs enrollment in virtually all formal sessions of each academic year, and added the technical-vocational enrollment topped 40 per cent for the first time with the 1968 fall term enrollment.

RESIDENT STUDENT enrollment accounted for slightly more than two-thirds of the total, and about two-thirds of the summer students are attending night classes, Dunn said. Men outnumber women students by more than three-to-one.

Although total enrollment was

up by 130 last year, full-time equaled enrollment—the figure on which the college is reimbursed by the state of Michigan—increased a fractional 9.3 students to 369.6 students.

"We have more students this year who are carrying one and two hours of credit work than we did in 1968," Dunn said. "And, we have fewer students this year carrying eight, nine, and 10 hours, than we had last year."

DUNN SAID the report for the summer session includes 455 students enrolled in 16-week classes, 12-week classes, and irregularly scheduled physical education classes, all of which fall outside the normal eight-week summer session schedule.

Federal's Earnings Up 39% In 1968

Federal's Inc., Detroit based operators of department and specialty stores, released preliminary earnings figures showing net income of \$2,435,000 or \$1.44 per share for its fiscal year ended July 26.

This represents an increase of 39.5 per cent over net earnings of \$1,743,900 or \$1.07 per share for the preceding fiscal year. Sales advanced to \$165,305,900 from \$148,993,000 last year, a gain of 9.6 per cent.

Both sales and earnings figures represent highs in the company's 37 year old history. The latest quarter ended July

26, is the 120th consecutive quarter to show an improvement in earnings over the like period in the prior year.

Sales and earnings of Federal Hardware & Supply Co., acquired in September '68 and Shifrin-Willens, Inc., a 14-unit jewelry chain acquired in April '69, have been included from the dates of their respective acquisitions.

J. Burke Gelling, chairman and president of Federal's Inc., stated that both acquisitions had displayed a favorable earnings trend during their first partial year of operation as subsidiaries of Federal's, Inc.

Since March, 1969, Federal's Inc., has opened five new full-line department stores averaging 80,000 sq. ft. each. The five new units are located in Flint, Kalamazoo, Lansing, Mich., Toledo, Ohio, and Buffalo, N.Y. Several locations for additional new full-line department stores as well as specialty stores are expected to be announced soon.

Bank Opens New Master Charge Plan

DETROIT Lawrence W. Dooly, vice president, Bank of the Commonwealth, will direct the bank's new Master Charge Plan—the internationally accepted bank charge card plan recently introduced to residents of this area.

Expecting many Michigan retailers to seek participation in the Commonwealth's Master Charge Card Plan, Dooly said: "Retailers have much to gain from this international bank credit card system. At present 20 million people are using Master Charge cards throughout the United States when they shop at over 500,000 retail outlets."

"We anticipate that local merchants will realize sales increases up to 20 per cent, not only from their regular customers, but also from new customers who will be attracted by the opportunity to use their Master Charge Cards."


