State study urged in child murders

A suburban state legislator has proposed a special study committee to find ways of preventing future child kidnappings and murders.

State Rep. Robert Law (R-Livonia) proposed the committee following the murder of 11-year-old Timothy King of Birmingham, whose body was found last week in a gravel road ditch in Livonia.

The boy was the seventh Oakland County youngster kidnaped and murdered in the past 15 months.

Law said he introduced a resolution calling for the special committee, which would consist of nine members "to study this problem and report its findings to the entire legislature as soon as possible."

Law said the state and specifically the three county area of Metropolitan Detroit "is fast approaching a crisis when it comes to the ability to protect children from molesting, kidnaping

and more permanent injury. Law enforcement agencies, while functioning at a high level, have had great difficulty in dealing with, and further difficulty in preventing, the opportunities for these kidnappings and molestings."

Law said this is a "good time to re-view the laws on the books, if any, that relate specifically to crimes committed against children. Perhaps we can propose greater safety measures and provide better educational programs in cooperation with local schools."

"Another potential solution that could be studied might include the formation of a task force of law enforcement experts in solving these types of crimes that could be called into action when such crimes occur."

Law noted that a colleague, Rep. David Campell to Clawson, has proposed a substantial reward fund to help catch the child killers.

Officials look into eatery fire

Southfield police and Southfield Fire Prevention Bureau officers are investigating an early Monday morning blaze which caused extensive damage to the Bonfire Restaurant on Eight Mile.

Walter Squires, operator of the restaurant, 20070 Eight Mile, was ordered March 25 by 48th District Court Judge Clarence Rent evicted from the premises for non-payment of rent, according to a court spokesman.

The first firefighters responded to the scene shortly before 9:30 a.m. Monday, March 28, said Southfield Fire Chief Donald Foote.

"The men found the dining room area of the restaurant engulfed in flames," Foote said. "The fire was under control in less than 30 minutes after 22 firefighters in five trucks fought the blaze."

Cause and origin of the fire are undetermined, Foote said. Damages have not been estimated.
