An August wedding is planned.



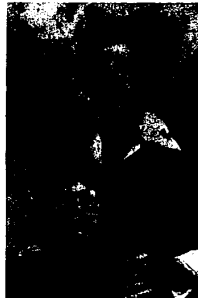
### Pollak-Turbow

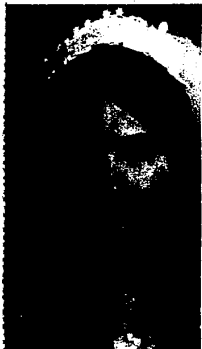
