

Dr. Glass says Type B botulinal toxin, the kind that affected the Oak-land County victims, is one of the kinds of botulism that affects humans. It comes from a bacterium spore that grows in places where there is no air.

WHEN IT IS ingested, the tooin of, fixes to nerves in the brain that affect life functions. The only way to treat it, according to Dr. Glass, it to give the patient an antitoxin which prevents the disease from getting worse by blocking the attaching surfaces of the free toxin.


