

CITY OF FARMINGTON COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

(Summary) A Regular Meeting of the Farmington City Council was held Monday, April 18, 1977 in the Council Chambers, 2000 Liberty Street, Farmington, Michigan; notice having been posted in compliance with Act 237 of the Michigan Legislature of 1976.

Present: Mayor Edward Kurtz, City Manager Donnell, Richard, Tupper and Yoder were present. City Manager Donnell, Directors Byrnes and Jones, Attorney Kelly and Clerk Vance were present.

Minutes of previous meeting were approved. Minutes of other boards were received. Council voted to allow Salvador Street to remain open during the construction of Eight Mile Road. Consideration of allowing Salvador Street to remain open pending the completion of the construction of Eight Mile Road is completed, contingent upon Farmington Hills bringing their portion of the road up to standards of a hard surfaced roadway.

Resolution regarding the To-County Transit Plan was tabled to the next regular meeting. Council was advised of a Memorial Ceremony that will be held at the Farmington Hills Council Meeting on April 25, 1977, for Joseph Terrence Brennan. Permission granted to South Farmington Baseball Field, Inc. for Opening Day Parade Saturday, May 7, 1977 at 11:00 a.m. Council favored support of HB 4473 and SB 344 pertaining to increasing the per capita support for Libraries and Library Systems throughout Michigan.

City Manager Donnell advised Council of a State Highway Commission meeting to be held April 27, 1977 in the Oakland County Auditorium, Pontiac, pertaining to North-western Hwy. and M275 (alternatives). Council supports City of Farmdale in calling for more favorable methods of collections made by minor children for newspaper routes. City Manager Donnell was instructed to communicate with the merchants on the North side of Grand River regarding their request for more parking facilities and to develop a cost analysis for acquisition of additional parking areas for consideration by Council. Council determined to allow Grace Street to remain a two-way street.

City Manager Donnell reported on progress of the 1977 Road Construction Program. City Manager Donnell was instructed to explore the possibility of making Freedom Road a one-way street from Orchard Lake Road to Haleswood with the City of Farmington Hills to contract the State Highway Department regarding allowing two-way traffic on Freedom Road in an effort to resolve the construction of an exit and entrance to 186 from Freedom Road.

Council authorized increase in SEMCO Membership Dues. Mr. Edward Kurtz, 3022 Cass C., requested repairs be made to Cass C. Building Department record received. The following appointments were made to the Farmington Area Commission on Aging: Mrs. Joan Crane, 3661 Veary Lane; Sister Clare Nicolai, O.P., 2319 Power Road. The following Ordinance was adopted:

ORDINANCE NO. 40177 TO AMEND CHAPTER 106 - TRAFFIC OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON AND TO ADOPT BY REFERENCE THE UNIFORM TRAFFIC CODE FOR MICHIGAN CITIES, TOWNSHIPS & VILLAGES.

Section 111 Code Adopted: The Uniform Traffic Code for cities, townships and villages promulgated by the Commissioner of State Police on January 14, 1968 and published in Supplement No. 13, and as amended on February 14, 1961 and published in Supplement No. 25, and on February 25, 1968 and published in Supplement No. 54, and on July 20, 1976 and published in Supplement No. 83 to the 1954 Michigan Administrative Code, in accordance with Public Act 62 of 1956, State of Michigan, is hereby adopted by Reference as in this Ordinance modified.

Section 112 Code: References in Code, References in the Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan Cities, Townships and Villages to "governmental unit" shall mean the City of Farmington. References to "this ordinance" shall mean CHAPTER 105 of this Code.

Section 113 Code: Copies to be Available: The City Clerk having published the ordinance adopting said Uniform Traffic Code in the manner required by law and having published supplementary notices setting forth the purpose of said Uniform Traffic Code and of the fact that complete copies of the Code are available at the Office of the City Clerk for inspection by and distribution to the public at all times, shall maintain copies in accordance with such supplementary notices.

Section 114 Code: Changes in Code: The following sections and subsections of the Uniform Traffic Code for Cities, Townships and Villages are hereby amended or deleted as set forth and additional sections and subsections are hereby added as set forth. Subsequent section numbers used in this Chapter shall refer to the like numbered sections of the Uniform Traffic Code.

Section 115 Code: Chapter 2 Section 217 Procedure Upon Arrest for Certain Offenses. AMEND LAST SUBSECTION (A) TO READ: "If under existing circumstances it does not appear that retaining such person pending the issuance of a warrant will constitute a hardship on the person, the arresting officer may issue a citation as is provided in Section 218 of this ordinance."

Section 220 No Stopping, Standing or Parking Zones. AMEND LAST SENTENCE TO READ: "Such zones shall be designated by posting proper signs at such locations. The distance between any two (2) such signs shall be that distance determined by the traffic engineer as an appropriate distance."

Section 226a Tow-away Zones. AMEND LAST SENTENCE OF SUBSECTION (D) TO READ: "Such zones shall be designated by posting proper signs at such locations. The distance between any two (2) such signs shall be that distance determined by the traffic engineer as an appropriate distance."

Section 323a Fleeting an Officer. ADD THE FOLLOWING PARAGRAPH: "A driver of a motor vehicle who has been stopped by a police officer and subsequently flees or attempts to flee or evade the officer, either by motor vehicle or on foot, shall be in violation of this Section."

Section 44 Section 44. ADD THE FOLLOWING PARAGRAPH TO SUBSECTION C: "Whenever traffic facing a steady red signal, after stopping before entering the crosswalk on the near side of the intersection, shall be permitted to turn right, or, if none, then before entering the intersection, shall be entering to make a right turn from a one-way or two-way street onto a two-way street or into a one-way street carrying traffic in the direction of the right turn; or a left turn from a one-way or two-way street into a one-way street carrying traffic in the direction of the left turn unless prohibited by sign, signal, marking, light or other traffic control device. The vehicular traffic shall yield the right-of-way to pedestrians lawfully within an adjacent crosswalk and to other traffic lawfully using the intersection."

Section 584 Making a False Report. ADD THE FOLLOWING SUBSECTION (B) TO READ: "It shall be unlawful for any person to willfully and knowingly make to any police officer a fictitious report giving false information relating to a traffic accident or violation of a City traffic or ordinance violation, knowing the same to be false."

Section 512 Violation of Signs. AMEND SECTION TO READ: "It shall be prima facie unlawful to exceed the speed limit stated on signs erected in accordance with the traffic laws of this government unit, and it shall be prima facie unlawful to drive at a speed lower than the posted minimum speed on any freeway except when reduced speed is necessary for safe operation or in compliance with law."

Section 515A Driving Under Influence of Intoxicating Liquor; Tests; Admissibility; Penalties; Liability for Withdrawing Blood; Refusal to Take Test; Implied Consent; Officer's Test Only. AMEND SUBSECTION (1) TO READ: "If there was at the time in excess of 0.07% but less than 0.10% by weight of alcohol in the defendant's blood, it shall be presumed that the defendant's ability to operate a motor vehicle was impaired within the provisions of Section 515B of the Code due to the consumption of intoxicating liquor."

Section 515B of the Code. AMEND SUBSECTION (6) TO READ: "Notwithstanding any other provision of this Code, a person requested to take this test shall be advised that he has the option of taking only a breath test shall be given, in which case his refusal to submit to any other test shall not constitute a refusal for the purposes of Sections 515C and 515D of this Code."

Section 516A Consumption of Liquor on Highways or Property Open to Public. AMEND LAST SENTENCE OF SUBSECTION 2 TO READ: "If the vehicle does not have a trunk or compartment separate from the passenger compartment, a container which is open or unsealed, or on which the seal is broken, shall be covered or enclosed. This Section shall not apply to a chartered passenger vehicle licensed by the Michigan Public Service Commission."

Section 520 Driving on a Shoulder. AMEND LAST SENTENCE OF SUBSECTION (D) TO READ: "It is no event shall such movement be made by driving off the pavement or maintenance shoulder of the roadway for the purpose of passing or driving."

Section 524A Driving in a Left Turn Only Lane. ADD THE FOLLOWING PARAGRAPH TO SUBSECTION A: "On streets where center lane is clearly marked and such lane is made for the exclusive use of vehicles desiring to turn left, it shall be unlawful to make such a left turn movement from any other lane and it shall further be unlawful for any vehicle to enter such lane except to make such a left turn movement and then only within the blocks immediately preceding the turn in which the turn is made provided that this Section shall not prohibit a left turn movement from this lane into a driveway, when such turn can be made in safety and without interfering with vehicles in such lane who are making an intended right turn. Any vehicle which enters the left turn lane only in the block within which the left turn is to be made."

Section 525A Improved Position and Method of Turning From a Roadway at Other Than 90 Degrees. ADD THE FOLLOWING NEW SECTION TO READ: "Turns from a roadway at other than an intersection, where a sign shall be made and the same shall be made from the same lane as specified in Section 531 for turns at an intersection."

Section 530 Right-of-Way, Vehicle Turning Left. AMEND SECTION TO READ: "When making a turn to the left shall yield the right-of-way to any vehicle approaching from the opposite direction which is so close as to constitute an immediate hazard, and said driver, having so yielded and having given a signal, shall stop and remain stopped until such time as he can safely and lawfully make the turn as required by this ordinance, may make such left turn and the driver shall yield the right-of-way to any vehicle approaching from the opposite direction shall yield the right-of-way to the vehicle making the left turn; provided that at an intersection at which a traffic sign is located, a driver intending to make a left turn shall permit vehicles bound straight through in the opposite direction which are waiting a go signal to pass through the intersection before making the turn."

Section 531 Right-of-Way, Vehicle Turning Right. AMEND SECTION TO READ: "Every driver shall have his operator's or chauffeur's license in his immediate possession at all times when driving a motor vehicle, and shall present the same upon the request of any police officer for the officer's inspection."

AMEND SECTION TO READ: "Every person driving a vehicle upon Farmington Public School District property shall drive the same at a careful and prudent speed not greater than that which is reasonable and proper, having due regard to the traffic, surface and width of the roadway and of other conditions then existing, and no person shall drive any vehicle upon a roadway at a speed greater than will permit him to bring it to a stop within the assured, clear distance ahead."

Section 115 Drag Racing. AMEND SECTION TO READ: "No person shall operate a motor vehicle upon Farmington Public School District property in a speed contest, including that commonly known as a drag race, whether from a standing start or otherwise over a measured or unmeasured distance, the object of which is to better defeat one or more contestants on the basis of elapsed time, superior performance or speed."

Section 116 Equipment. AMEND SECTION TO READ: "It is a misdemeanor for any person to drive or move or for the owner to cause to be driven or moved on properties for which this Ordinance applies any vehicle or combination of vehicles which does not contain those parts or is not at all times equipped with such lamps and other equipment in proper condition and adjustment as required in this Ordinance, or which is equipped in any manner in violation of this Ordinance."

Section 117 Brakes. AMEND SECTION TO READ: "Every motor vehicle when operated on properties for which this Ordinance applies shall be equipped with brakes adequate to control the movement of and to stop and hold such vehicle."

Section 118 Horns and Other Warning Devices. AMEND SECTION TO READ: "Every motor vehicle when operated on properties for which this Ordinance applies shall be equipped with a horn in good working order and capable of emitting sound audible under normal conditions from a distance of not less than 200 feet but no horn or other warning device shall emit an unreasonable or harsh sound or whistle. The driver of a motor vehicle shall when reasonably necessary to insure safe operation, give audible warning with two horns but shall not otherwise use them when upon properties for which this Ordinance applies."

Section 119 Mufflers. AMEND SECTION TO READ: "Every motor vehicle shall at all times be equipped with a muffler in good working order and in constant operation to prevent excessive or unusual noise and annoying smoke, and no person shall use a muffler cut-out, bypass or similar device upon a vehicle on properties for which this Ordinance applies."

Section 120 Mirrors. AMEND SECTION TO READ: "No person shall drive a motor vehicle on properties for which this Ordinance applies which is equipped with a rearview mirror or a side or rear view mirror, or both, which do not meet the requirements of this Ordinance. Every commercial vehicle of 15 ton capacity or more shall be equipped with two mirrors, one on each side, so adjusted that the operator will have a clear view of the area behind such commercial vehicle."

Section 121 Windshields. AMEND SECTION TO READ: "No person shall drive any motor vehicle with any sign, poster or other non-permanent material attached to the front windshield, side wings or side or rear windows of such window which obstructs the driver's clear view of the highway or properties for which this Ordinance applies, or with any dangling ornament or other suspended object, except as authorized by law which in no way obstructs the vision of the driver of the vehicle."

Section 122 Permitted Vehicles. AMEND SECTION TO READ: "Only motor vehicles licensed as such by the Michigan Department of State, or other Michigan agency having jurisdiction over the operation of motor vehicles on the public highways of the state may be operated on properties belonging to the Farmington Public School District."

Section 123 Prohibited Parking. AMEND SECTION TO READ: "No person shall park a vehicle in any of the following places: On a sidewalk. In front of any driveway. Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant of instructional building. On a designated cross walk. At any place where other signs prohibit parking. At any place where parking is permitted for specific purposes unless the occupants of said vehicle are complying with the requirements of said permitted uses. On more than one designated parking space. On any grass or otherwise landscaped area. On a playground or playing field. On any street or highway. Motor Vehicle. No person having control or charge of a motor vehicle shall allow such vehicle on property for which this Ordinance applies unattended without effective measures to prevent the vehicle from being driven away. Standing upon any grade without turning front wheels of such vehicle to the curb or side of the property for which this Ordinance applies."

Section 124 Deposition of Debris on Roadways. AMEND SECTION TO READ: "No person shall throw or deposit upon any driveway, parking lot, playground, playfield, or other area, any glass bottle, glass, nails, tacks, wire, cans, rubbish, garbage, or any other substance likely to injure any person, animal or vehicle upon such area. Any person who drops, or permits to be dropped or thrown, upon any area any destructive or injurious material shall immediately remove the same or cause it to be removed. Any person removing a wrecked or damaged vehicle from a driveway or parking lot shall remove any glass or other injurious substance dropped upon the area. This Section shall not apply to a chartered passenger vehicle licensed by the Michigan Public Service Commission."

Section 125 Consumption of Liquor on Roadways and Parking Areas. AMEND SECTION TO READ: "No alcoholic liquid shall be consumed on property for which this Ordinance applies."

Section 126 Severability Clause. AMEND SECTION TO READ: "If any section, provision, phrase or word of this Ordinance shall be held void, such section, provision, phrase or word of competent jurisdiction shall be held void, in whole or in part, and the validity of the remaining sections, provisions, phrases or words hereof shall not be affected."

Section 127 Penalties. AMEND SECTION TO READ: "Any person, firm, corporation, partnership, association or society that violates any of the provisions of Sections 113 through 118 of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be subject to a fine of not more than One Hundred (100) Dollars and/or confinement in the County Jail for a period of not exceeding ninety (90) days, or both. Each act or omission in violation of the provisions hereof shall be deemed a separate offense and shall be punishable accordingly."
