40 Years Of Change Pictured

A special exhibit of painings, lithographs and sketches will soon be on view in the Round Hall of the Detroit Historical Museum. The exhibit is an artist's reflection of scenes in Detroit that are gone or in the process of change. The exhibit is scheduled from Sept. 2 to Sept. 30.

Detroit artist, John Z, Gei-savage has painted views of De-troit streets and buildings over the past 40 years, and his paint-ings reveal a love for the city's old houses which, "like old peo-ple, take on a charm and beauty all of their own."

Approximately 80 scenes will be included in Gelsavage's view of Detroit, A number were created in the 1930's and re-flect the years of depression, their grimmes and despair as well as the perseverance and hope that characterized this era of the common man.

The artist left people out of his pictures "to give the houses a chance to speak for them-selves." His paintings adfor future generations the transient spirit of Detroit's old houses.

The Detroit Historical Mu-seum previously presented an exhibit of 25 paintings by Gel-savage pertaining to labor his-tory. The artist has long been concerned with interpreting the labor movement and laboring people.




