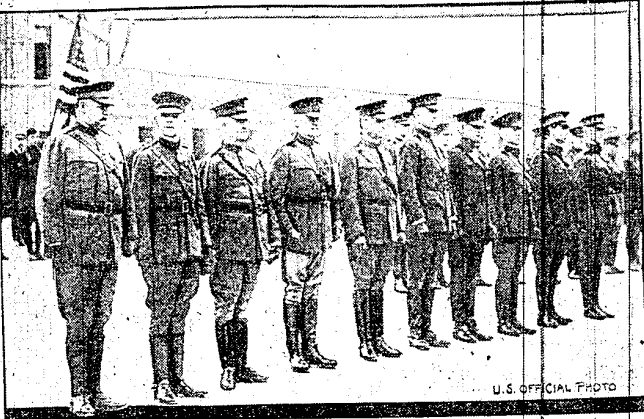
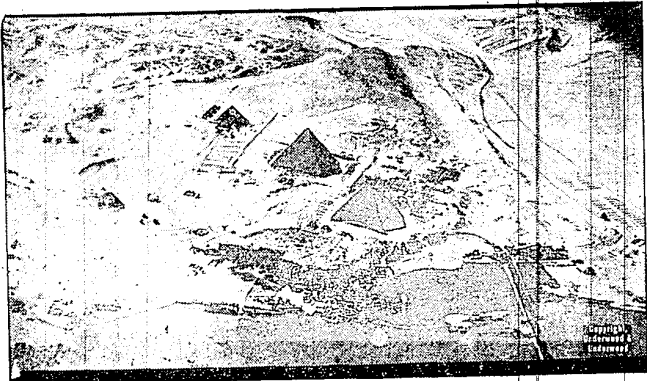


TEN AMERICAN GENERALS HONORED BY FRANCE

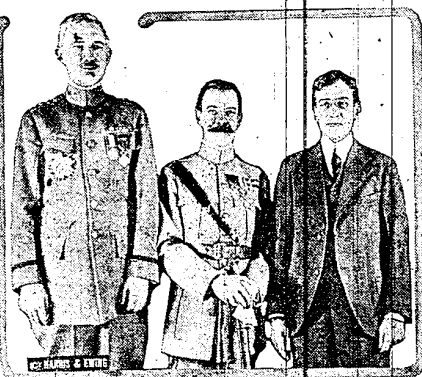
Fish as Fertilizing Material.

The oldest industry to make use of waste for fertilizing is the fish industry. The custom of fertilizing crops with fish existed among the Indians of New England before the arrival of white settlers. It is said that for fertilizing corn one or two fish were buried in each hill. This procedure was adopted by the colonists, and at the time of a large catch the surplus fish were simply spread broadcast over the fields. In places where fish were plentiful this deposit of an overabundance of fish has been practical until very recent times.
