Paris.—The covenant of the League of Nations in revised form, moved by President Wilson, was adopted April 27-by the peace conference in plenary session without a dissenting vote. President: Wilson, addressing the conference, explained the amendments to the League of Nations covennul. He did not read the entire revised text.
