On Tuesday, Nov. 4, people in the City of Farmington, Farmington Township, and the Village of Quakerstown and Woodstock Farms will go to the polls and indicate whether they are or are not in favor of consolidation.

The actual wording on the first part of the ballot will read:

"For consolidation of the City of Farmington, Farmington Township and the Village of Quakerstown and Woodstock Farms. Yes \_\_\_ No \_\_\_"

A SECOND part of the ballot will indicate a list of names for the charter commission.

Do not believe anyone who deceptively tells you you are voting on whether a charter commission shall be empowered to write a charter for the purpose of consolidating the City of Farmington, Farmington Township and the Village of Quakerstown and Woodstock Farms, nothing to do with what it does say.

Because we believe in the seriousness of the question, we are opposed to any political shenanigans in the consideration of the question.

SHOULD A majority in any of

## Allen's Wrong And Knows It

City Councilman John Allen for the past few weeks has been writing articles on consolidation in which The Enterprise & Observer has been printing. In today's article, he is dead wrong, and he knows he's wrong. His intent is to cloud the issue by casting doubts on the facts, but the facts are written into the law, and the law stands by itself.

### Editorial

Allen implies the vote Nov. 4 is a final vote on consolidation. It isn't, and John knows it isn't. Act 191 in clear English vocabulary states that, to consolidate, a charter commission must first be elected and then a charter approved on a second ballot. The final vote on consolidation, then, is not taken until the second ballot when the charter is presented.

Anyone versed in government knows you cannot form a new government without voter approval of a new charter. Charters must be written by a commission by mandate of the electorate. John knows this, and regardless of his personal wishes there WILL be a second, and final, vote on consolidation because that's what the law says. We are not confused!
