Football fans will be able to board buses at Northland, Eastland, and Wonderland shopping centers for comfortable rides to all Lion home games.

'Football Flyer' Buses Fans To Lions' Games

The Detroit Department of Street Railways (DSR) General Manager Robert F. Toohay announced that the popular "Football Flyer" bus service will be operating again this year.

The "Flyers" carry football fans from outlying shopping centers to Detroit-Lion home games at Tiger Stadium and back.

General Manager Toohay said, "The \$1.50 round-trip fare on the 'Football Flyers' coupled with the comfort of letting someone else fight

traffic and find parking adds up to a real bargain and a real pleasure to the fan who avails himself of the service."

THE THREE shopping centers involved are Northland, Eastland, and Wonderland. The use of Westland has been discontinued.

"Football Flyer" service will begin on Sunday, Sept. 28, 1969, and will be available for all Lion home games.

For Sunday games, the first coaches will leave the shopping centers at 11:15 a.m. and except

for Wonderland the last coaches will leave at 12:45 p.m. The last Wonderland coach leaves at 12:30 p.m.

ON THANKSGIVING Day, the first coaches leave Wonderland and Eastland at 10:15 a.m. and from Northland at 10:30 a.m. The final coaches to the game will leave Wonderland at 11:30 a.m., from Northland at 11:45 a.m., and from Eastland at 11:45 a.m.

Wonderland coaches will stop for passengers on Grand River at Oakman and at McGraw. Return trips will start as the buses fill following the games.

Fares are 75 cents each way. Riders must have the correct fare in coins.

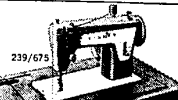

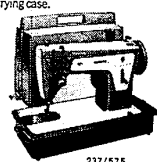

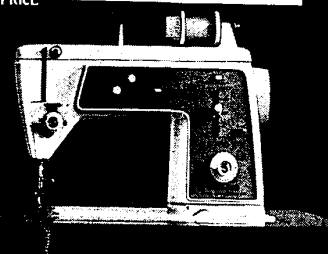

Oakland Announces Plays For School Tour Program

ROCHESTER "Under Milk Wood," a Welsh "Our Town," will be the first production taken on tour this season by the Studio Company of Oakland University's Academy of Dramatic Art.

The Dylan Thomas play, now available for out-of-town bookings at schools, colleges, churches and clubs, will be staged from Nov. 10 through Nov. 26.

Potential sponsoring organizations are urged to choose their dates soon since all reservations are confirmed on a first-come, first-served basis, and many matinees already are taken. Evening performances also are available.

THE SECOND offering, Dec. 8 through 19, will be a triple bill of one-acts by Thornton Wilder, Eugene Ionesco and Harold Pinter. These three internationally known playwrights represent the best of 20th century drama.

By popular demand of area teachers, plays by Shakespeare figure prominently in this year's repertoire. Two of the Bard's delightful comedies will be offered, "Twelfth Night" slated for Feb. 9 through 20, and "As You Like It" from March 9 through 27.

The season will close with a Restoration Comedy the first three weeks in May.

FOR THOSE schools or organizations which have no stages they can use arrangements have been made to hold ADA Studio Company performances in Meadow Brook Theatre four evenings the week before the plays are taken on tour. Study guides and programs are furnished for each play.

Need Ledger Strip

Construction for an above-grade wood deck starts with a ledger strip, a 2x4 or 2x6-inch piece nailed or bolted to the house wall. The ledger supports the joists on that side of the deck. Joists are supported on beams farther out from the house.

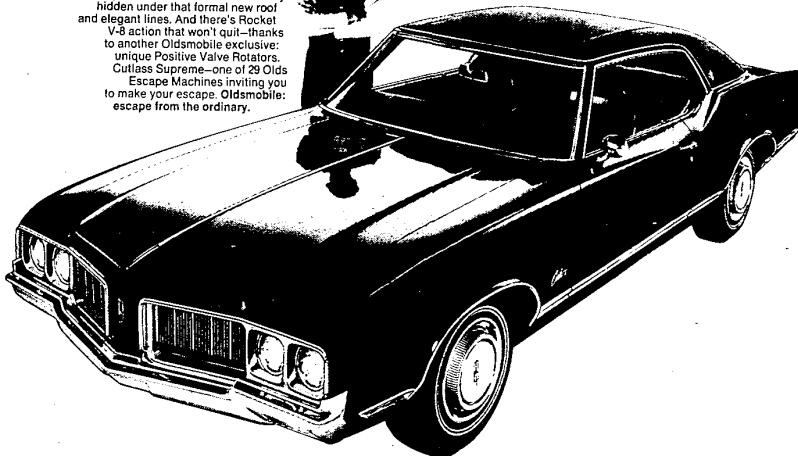
