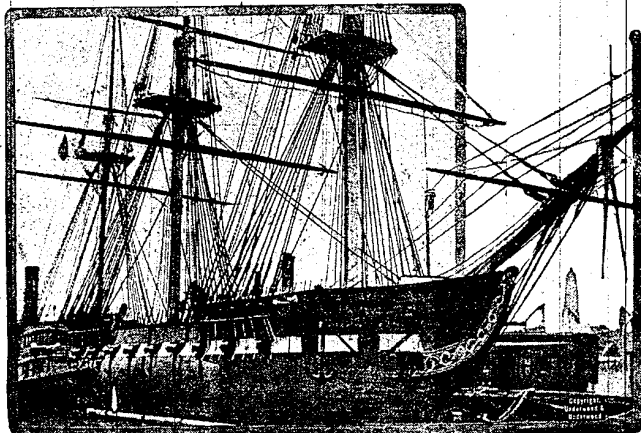

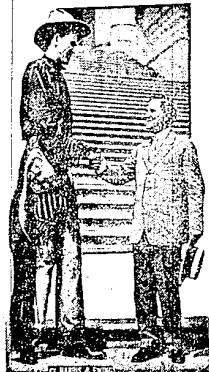

The Excuse.

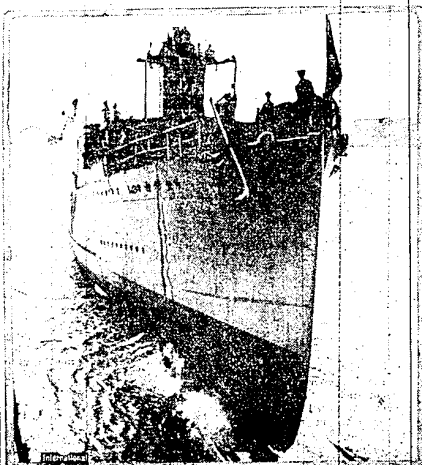
"Ludendorff," said Representative Shouse, "is telling the world the reason why he lost the war. Ludendorff's excuse reminds me of the Irishman."

Court Rules Against Tradition.

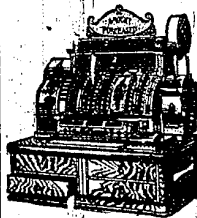
