Buyers of new houses can expect to find "price adjustment" clauses in their purchase contracts.

The culprit is a 15 per cent inflation in the cost of building materials during 1977, with further lakes expected in 1978.

Materials are about one-third the cost of a house. "How can we trust builders to pass on only the actual increases in materials costs, and not use the clause as an excuse to tack five per cerá onto the price?" Yackness was asked.

"There's a cap of five per cent in the clauses we're suggesting," said Yackness, pointing to one sample which said "in no event shall the price be increased for any reason whatsoever by more than five per cent."

A second buyer protection, Yackness said, is that the U.S. Labor Department each month publishes an industrial production commodities index. It would be the guide.

Finally, he said, the clause works wo ways. Price drops would have to be reflected in the price of the house.

We ve had reports from many builders who say they can't keep pace with price escalation, 'said Yackness, explaining why BASM drafted the clauses.

"We are apprehensive other builders face bankrupicy because they cannot anticipate today what their costs will be at the time of closing."

Isn't it the builders' tough luck if they go broke? No, said Yackness, because fewer builders means less choice for the buyer and a smaller housing supply.

A COMPLICATING factor for builders is the length of time it takes to build a house.

"It used to take 90 days. Some builders could finish a house in 60 days," said Yachness.

"Now it takes seven to nine months. There are various reasons for that.

"The inspection process is very lengthy. One community. Canton Township, requires Zi inspections.

"We ve had extreme weather this year that has held up building." And then there's the availability of mechanics. There's lintense competition for bricklayers here." Some builders said that during the building stimp that occurred in the region for the past few years, many
